## BENCHMARKING

### *The Impact of COVID-19 on Worksite Health Centers*

In March 2020, NAWHC asked employers what services they were offering in their centers during the COVID-19 crisis:

- ▶ Telephonic COVID-19 screening – 85%
- ▶ Prescription refills – 81%
- ▶ Virtual office visits – 74%
- ▶ Services for those onsite – 64%
- ▶ Temperature screenings – 55%
- ▶ COVID-19 testing – 55%
- ▶ Telephonic management of COVID-19 symptoms – 55%
- ▶ Behavioral health services – 47%
- ▶ Wellness coaching – 47%
- ▶ Return to work – 40%
- ▶ Collection of testing samples – 34%
- ▶ Physical medicine – 26%
- ▶ Open to community – 4%

A new survey on worksite health centers' response to the COVID-19 environment is planned for late July to provide an update for members.
