2024 Onsite Employee Health Clinics Summit – Feb. 1-2, 2024, Hilton Scottsdale Resort, Scottsdale, Arizona



A recent NAWHC survey on vaccines and cancer screening offered by employers, clinic managers and health providers who offer onsite and near-site centers found the following vaccines being provided:




- Other vaccines offered were: Tdap, rabies, pneumonia, tetanus and yellow fever.

BCBS OF AZ Offering Employer Clinics

In a story in the [Phoenix Business Journal](#), it was reported that BCBS of Arizona is beginning to offer onsite and near-site clinics, not only to its own employees and dependents, but also to other area employers. Each clinic is staffed with doctors, nurse practitioners, lab technicians and administrative support staff, led by a clinic manager. The health insurance giant has ambitious plans to open multiple care center locations in the Valley next year, ultimately stretching down into Tucson by 2025. The clinics, which the company has dubbed "advance primary care centers," are operated by a new subsidiary, called Prosano Health Solutions Inc.
