

Challenges in Opening a New Clinic

In the 2018 NAWHC-Gallagher benchmarking survey, employers with clinics were asked what their major challenges in were om opening and expanding the number of clinics for their covered populations. Improving Access to Behavioral Health Service

A recent Mercer study of employer EAP programs identified the number of organizations offering different types of behavioral health services that a worksite center could offer:

- 91% offer telephonic coaching
- 89% offer face-to-face counseling
- 54% provide manager/supervisor training on handling behavioral health issues
- 24% offer video-based counseling
- 13% provide text-based coaching
- 8% offer text-based therapy
